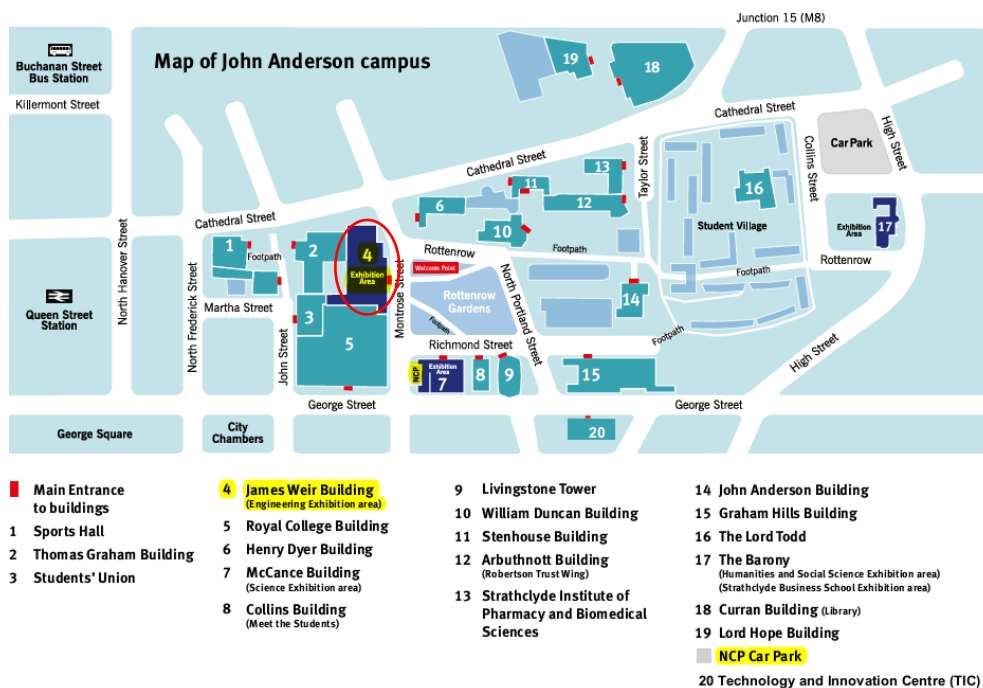

Laboratory tours

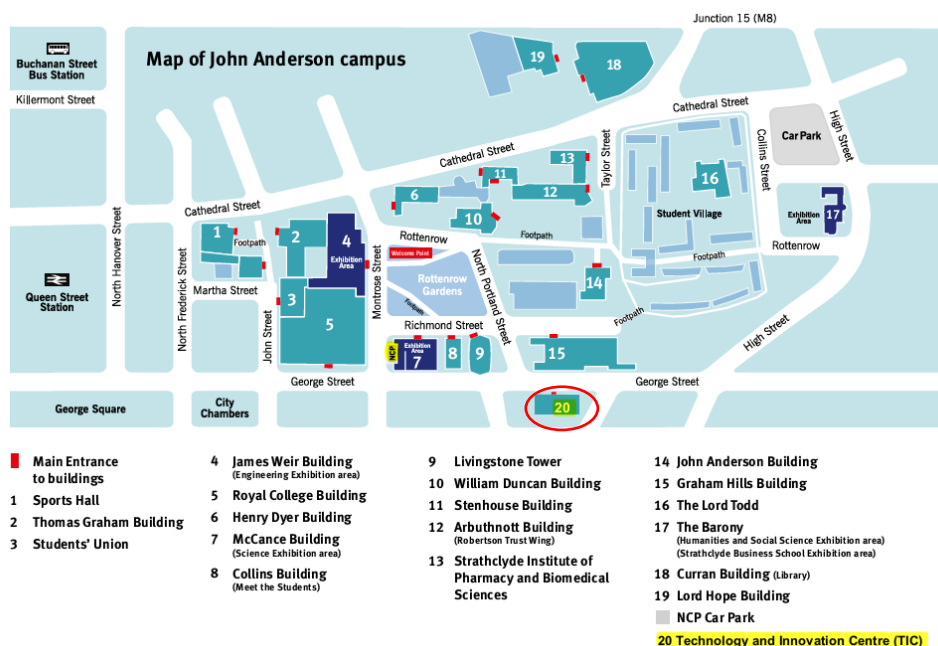
